TWO THEOLOGICAL PILLARS


Pillar 1

Monotheism. There is one Creator. One Sovereign God. His name is YHWH. See Isaiah 43:10.



Trinity. Three Persons. One God. YHWH exists as three unique, distinct, co-equal, eternal persons. Father. Son. Spirit.




